



KeyCare Screening and Prevention Benefit 2011

Preventative screening is crucial to make sure you detect medical conditions early so we can ensure the best care for you.

The Screening and Prevention Benefit covers one mammogram, one pap smear and one prostate-specific antigen test for each person each year. We also cover HIV tests up to the Discovery Health Rate.

These tests must be referred by an appropriate medical professional and you can visit any pathologist or radiologist to have them done.

The Screening and Prevention Benefit provides cover for an annual seasonal flu vaccination for members from the age of 65 and members registered for certain chronic conditions:

1. Asthma
2. Bronchiectasis
3. Cardiac Failure
4. Cardiomyopathy
5. Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
6. Chronic Renal Disease
7. Coronary Artery Disease
8. Diabetes (Types 1 and 2)
9. HIV.

* The list of chronic conditions is subject to change

- Members can go to a doctor or to a pharmacy for their flu vaccine
- Eligible members will be covered for **one** seasonal flu vaccine per year
- KeyCare members who do not meet the above criteria will have to fund the flu vaccine from their pocket.

The Screening and Prevention Benefit also covers a group of tests for each person each year, up to a maximum amount. The member must have this group of tests done at the same time. We will cover up to one group of tests from the Screening and Prevention Benefit so if you have the tests done on different days, you will need to pay for them. The Screening and Prevention Benefit covers the following preventive screening tests at a participating pharmacy:

- Blood pressure
- Blood glucose
- Cholesterol screening
- Body mass index.
